

CIA – EXAMINATION PROCEDURE

1. Program Overview

The CIA British Council® is a professional certification in internal auditing offered under the General Institute of Certification Management in collaboration with British Council® affiliates.

It is designed for professionals seeking to validate their expertise in risk management, governance, internal controls, and audit techniques.

The program is structured into three parts:

Part 1: Essentials of Internal Auditing

Part 2: Practice of Internal Auditing

Part 3: Business Knowledge for Internal Auditing

2. Examination Format

Mode: Online (remotely proctored) or in-person (subject to center availability)

Duration: 2.5 to 3 hours per part

Total Marks per Part: 100

Question Type:

Primarily descriptive and case study-based

Includes scenario analysis and applied reasoning

Medium of Exam: English

3. Passing Requirements

Minimum 50% in each part to qualify

No negative marking

Candidates may reattempt any failed part without re-taking the entire certification

4. Certification Award

Upon passing all three parts:

You will be awarded the CIA British Council® Certification

Your name will be listed in the official register of certified auditors

You will be eligible for further specialization or exemptions (subject to region-specific policies)
